





Notice of race

Open Swedish Championship for IOM 2020

Saturday 26th and Sunday 27th of September 2020

1. Organizing Authority

The Swedish Championship for IOM 2020 is organized by Stockholms Radiosegelsällskap (SRSS) and Nynäshamns Segelsällskap (NSS) and Enmeterförbundet (SWE IOM-NCA).

2. Venue

The championship will be held in Nynäshamn (approximately 40 km south of Stockholm).

3. Rules

- 3.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). as amended by the RRS Appendix E, this Notice of Race (NoR), the Sailing Instructions (SI), the International IOM Class Rules and The Equipment Rules of Sailing.
- 3.2 The Swedish government and the Public Health Authority have issued rules and regulations in relation to the Corona pandemic. Competitors shall respect these rules and recommendations as directed by the Organising Authority or Race Committee in either Notice of Race, Sailing Instructions or orally. A competitor or crew that does not comply with this rule, may be penalized by the Protest Committee as a discretionary penalty (DP). Rule 36 does not apply for a penalty under this rule.

- 3.3 In case of umpired fleet racing, IRSA Addendum Q shall apply.
- 3.4 If the fleet is divided into two or more heats Heat Management System 2016 shall apply.
- 3.5 The Sailing Instructions shall prevail in case of conflict with this Notice of Race.

4. Eligibility requirements

- 4.1 To be entitled to participate in championships sanctioned by the Swedish Sports Federation, each competitor shall comply with ISAF Regulation 19.
 In order to be awarded the title Swedish Champion (SM) the competitors shall be Swedish citizens or have resided in Sweden for at least six months the last twelve months before the event starts.
- 4.2 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 4.3 Swedish competitors shall hold a valid license for competition on a national level in accordance with Swedish Sailing Federation regulations.

5. Entries

- 5.1 The number of competitors is limited to 36.
- 5.2 Entries shall be submitted no later than Wednesday, September 9^c, 2020. Each entry shall include Name, Sail Number, Club, e-mail address, mobile telephone number.
- 5.3 Competitors register via <u>www.srss.se</u> under the section: "Anmälan" where you choose the event and press the icon under "Registrering" to get access to the entry form.
- 5.4 The entries will be allocated places as per below and the list of competitors will be published on <u>www.srss.se</u> no later than Friday September 11th.

If more than 36 entries on September 9th 24.00 hrs the following will prevail.

Swedish entries are allocated places as per the Swedish "Rankinglista" valid on September 9th 2020. Foreign entries will be allocated by the discretion of the organisers who shall take into account the submitted NCA prioritised lists, previous results in Swedish and International championships. 5.5 The entry fee is SEK 600 including lunch & coffee to be paid latest by Friday, September 18th 2020 to:

5.6 Each entry will only be valid subject that the entry fee is paid on time.

6. Time schedule

09:00 First warning signal Lunch break when suitable. 15:30 No heat will be started after this time Price giving ceremony will commence as soon as possible after the results are calculated and presented.

6.1 Lunch and refreshments during both days of the event is included in the entry fee.

7. Registration and measurement checks

7.1 Boats, together with their valid measurement certificates shall be presented for registration before 09:15 on September 26th. However, the Race Committee may extend the time for registration and event measurement if there is a valid reason to do so. No boat shall be eligible for racing until it has been registered and and has passed event measurement. Where to register will be announced in the Sailing Instructions.

8. Sailing Instructions

8.1 The sailing instructions will be published on <u>www.srss.se</u> no later than Monday, September 21st.

9. Race format and scoring

- 9.1 The Racing system will be HMS 2016. Fleet racing will be considered as an option whenever fever than 20 boats are starting at any race scheduled.
- 9.2 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

10. Racing area

10.1 The racing area will be on the long floating dock protecting the northeastern part of Nynäshamn Guest harbour.

11. Frequencies:

11.1 Only applicable if you are not using 2.4GHz: Permitted frequencies other than 2.4GHz are: 27MHz, 35MHz. Bring at least two frequencies.

12. Prizes

- 12.1 Prices will be given by a total number equal to one for every five competitor having started in the regatta.
- 12.2 Swedish Championship plaquette and titles may be awarded to Swedish competitors if six or more boats from at least three different Swedish clubs located in more than one Swedish districts have crossed the finish line in one race in the championship.
